Construction & Infrastructure Projects

Construction Entrance Turn Lane:

As a result of increased construction in the club, early morning truck, trailer and van traffic had been backing up from the construction gate onto South Shore Blvd causing an extremely hazardous situation during critical commuting hours. The Village of Wellington (VOW) requested that the construction gate be shut down, and construction

traffic routed back to the East and West gates. The POA suggested that moving traffic to the two existing gates would simply create two new hazards, but that lengthening the existing construction road by utilizing POA land adjacent to South Shore Blvd would be a far more effective solution.

The VOW agreed, and plans were drawn up by the POA and approved by

We wish Sheila and Matt great success and hope you will support their efforts. the VOW. The POA was to undertake construction with a December 1, 2016 target date of completion. Unfortunately, due to several unforeseen (and unwelcomed) change demands requested by the VOW, construction completion is now approximated to be February 15.

We apologize for the delay; however, the power to accelerate construction was out of our hands.

<u>Installation of New</u> <u>Lighting:</u>

The first stage of multiple upgrades to our lighting grid, transformers and underground wiring is rapidly coming to conclusion. New lighting will soon be operational along Polo Club Road and will continue to be upgraded over a period of years to, finally, encompass the entire community.

This project was also scheduled for completion prior to the season. Unfortunately, Hurricane Matthew forced Florida Power and Light (FPL) to concentrate their efforts in the northern part of the state, thus delaying delivery and installation of our transformer into late December.

We fully expect the lighting installation to result in improved visibility and to greatly enhance the visual effect along Polo Club Road.

Access Control Update

Safe Communities Vendor ID Program

Effective March 1, 2017

As part of Palm Beach Polo & Country Club Property Owners' Association, Inc.'s ongoing efforts to improve access control and security throughout the community, the POA is implementing a Safe Communities Vendor ID Program with implementation scheduled for March 1, 2017.

All permanent vendors entering the community must have a criminal background check and driver's license check. Once screened, each vendor will carry the "Safe Communities Vendor ID" card, which is accepted by communities and employers throughout Palm Beach County. The vendor ID card will be scanned each time the employee(s) arrive at Palm Beach Polo.

Vendors that do not meet the following background criteria will not be issued an ID card:

Standardized Background Criteria

- > No convictions in the past five years for:
 - o Robberv
 - o Theft
 - Burglary
 - Sex Offenses
 - Aggravated Crimes of Violence or Dealing in Stolen Property
- > No Sexual Offender / Predator Status
- *Adjudication Withheld, Plea Agreements, Pre-Trial Intervention, Probation, etc...are all considered the same as guilty / convictions.
 - *Nolle Prosse, No File, Dropped / Abandoned & Not Guilty are all eligible for ID's.

Safe Communities Vendor ID Program

ID Application Process

The entire ID application process is completed online at www.SafeVendor.net.

Type in your information, download a head-shot photo and a photo of a supporting document from any computer or smart phone.

Supporting documents include:

- ➤ Government Issued Driver's License
- Government Issued ID Card
- Passport
- Other Government Issued Photo ID
- Consular Photo ID

The vendor or employer must pay for the ID online through a secure payment system with a debit or credit card. If the vendor meets the criteria, an ID card will be mailed out to the POA office within 24 hours and then issued to the vendor during their next visit to the community.

The fee for the entire process is \$35.00 per applicant and the ID (valid for one year after issuance) allows entry into all communities participating in the Safe Community Vendor program.

The program does not include immigration status or work status screening.

The following vendors will be required to have a valid Safe Community Vendor ID:


- Landscapers / Irrigation Contractors (all employees)
- ➤ Housekeepers / Domestic Employees
- Pool Company's (all employees)
- ➤ Laundry / Dry Cleaning Delivery Employees
- > Air Conditioner / Plumbing vendors who perform routine maintenance
- ➢ Golf Cart vendors
- Car Wash vendors
- Pressure Washing vendors
- ➤ Alarm / Security Camera vendors
- > Vendors performing projects lasting over one week in duration
